CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) - UPDATE

We are almost at full strength as most of our employees have returned to the workplace. With previous limits on holidays starting to ease, as per Government guidance, we are likely to see personal leave start to be taken up again. However, we will control the level of absence to ensure we are covering all the requirements of our customers.

Most of our supply chain around the world are getting back to some form of normality. Only India remains a concern, but we are monitoring all supplies from this region daily to ensure minimal impact.

We are regularly being asked when witness inspection activities would be allowed at our site again. I can confirm that we are still restricting visitors to our site for the time being as we retain our 2-metre distancing rule. Whilst the UK Government is allowing easing of the 2-metre rule, Oliver's are maintaining our internal arrangements for the foreseeable future. I reiterate the message that was in the May 2020 update, that our remote witness inspection facilities are fully operational and working successfully. I kindly ask that you use this opportunity in the short-term to cover witness activities.

I would also like to thank all our customers for their patience and understanding during these challenging times. You can rest assured that all our employees are working hard to provide the kind of service you expect from us.
